Second Collection this week for **Day for Life**: a collection started at the request of Pope John Paul II, used to support The Anscombe Bioethics Centre and causes that come under the theme of the year.

Prayers and Action Please! MPs will debate and vote next week (*if selected for debate*) – **on either Tuesday 17 or Wednesday 18 June** – on extreme abortion up to birth amendments to the Crime and Policing Bill. These proposed law changes represent the most serious threat to unborn children since the Abortion Act was introduced in 1967. Then, just days later, on **Friday 20 June**, MPs will place their final vote on the Leadbeater Assisted Suicide Bill. This means we are now facing the most significant votes on both abortion and assisted suicide in a generation – **all within the same week**. These are two major battles, and they're happening back to back. Please pray for a defeat to both. Please can you also contact your MP to oppose both the Assisted Suicide Bill and Abortion up to birth amendments to the Crime and Policing Bill.
